The Paris Agreement established a future for carbon markets under Article 6. While the rulebook is still being negotiated, pilot activities around the world are offering first lessons to be taken into account in the operationalization. This workshop therefore convenes and addresses key stakeholders interested in Article 6 piloting and results-based climate finance from both buyers and seller countries.

The session will be organized jointly by Perspectives Climate Group, South Pole and the World Bank. Perspectives is leading the “Climate Finance Innovators” project and launched the first comprehensive study on Article 6 piloting and will share observations and lessons learned from Article 6 readiness and piloting in low-income countries in Africa and LDCs. South Pole will present key considerations from middle-income countries with a focus on piloting activities in Colombia while the World Bank will discuss sub-regional aspects of the piloting activities.
